U2CI installation procedure for Mac OS 10.6+ Rev 1.2 – Released on August 27, 2008

- 1. Download U2CI For Mac OS 10.5.zip from our website
- 2. Open the "Finder"
- 3. Look under "Places" *(on the left side of window)* and select **your** User Account (usually located below "Desktop")
- 4. Look in "Downloads" for "U2CI For Mac OS 10.5"
- 5. Now open the "Mac OS 10.5+ Driver" folder and double click on FTDIUSBSerialDriver_v2_2_9(.dmg)
- Double click the FTDIUSBSerialDriver, to install the driver follow the onscreen prompts; you may need a password – you may be prompted to restart – click restart
- After restarting your computer; re-do steps 3 and 4; and move the "Mac OS 10.5+ Driver" folder to the trash; then move the "U2CI For Mac" folder into "Applications"
- 8. Everything is ready for you to start using your UDock. Plug your uDock into an available USB port prior to starting the U2CI software
- Open the "U2CI For Mac" folder (now in Applications) and double click on "U2CI-OSX-V1.1.3-release" to start the U2CI application. WARNING: <u>Do</u> <u>NOT move anything out of this folder or the program will not work</u>. You may make an alias for "U2CI-OSX-V1.1.3-release" if you wish
